Dear Supervisors:

On behalf of the applicant, Fairfield Management Corporation, Bohler Engineering PA, LLC is hereby submitting for review a Waiver of Land Development for the proposed improvements at the above-referenced site.

As an introduction, a description of the proposed improvement and reason for the improvement is as follows:

The applicant proposes to construct a $\pm 7,000$ square foot building expansion with an $\pm 1,800$ square foot common area to the existing $\pm 94,000$ square foot Courtney II building. The combined $\pm 8,871$ square foot building expansion is needed to support the growth of an existing tenant and serve to expand the current uses of warehousing and light assembly as permitted by the zoning district.

In accordance with the Township's Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance Section, please find the following justification for the waiver request:

- <u>No Stormwater Management Required</u> Lot coverage is proposed to remain unchanged with no increase of impervious cover. Therefore, there is no increase in stormwater and no requirement to manage stormwater.
- <u>No change in Use</u> The additional building square footage is proposed as an extension of the existing warehousing and light assembly uses and there is no proposed change of use.
- No NPDES Requirement The proposed area of work does not exceed 1 acre of disturbance, thereby exempting the project from the requirements of an NPDES permit.
- <u>No LVPC Review</u> There is no proposed increase to impervious surfaces, thereby exempting the project from the requirement of LVPC review and approval.
- <u>Erosion & Sediment Control</u> Minimal earth disturbance is proposed as there is no change in cover type and due to scope of the improvements and location of the building addition, minimal erosion and sediment controls are anticipated to be required as part of the construction process.

For the reasons set forth herein, the Applicant requests that a Waiver of Land Development for the proposed project be granted and that the matter be placed on the agenda for the February 25, 2020 Board of Supervisors Meeting for review and approval.
