#### PROCLAMATION NO. 2022 – 5

To recognize National Police Office Week 2022 and to honor the service and sacrifice of those law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities and safeguarding our democracy.

WHEREAS, there are approximately 650,000 law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Colonial Regional Police Department; and

WHEREAS, nearly 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries; and

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1791 through 2020, 22,611 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, the service and sacrifice of all officers killed in the line of duty were honored during the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund's 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Candlelight Vigil, on the evening of May 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Candlelight Vigil is part of National Police Week, which takes place this year on May 11<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>; and

WHEREAS, May 15<sup>th</sup> is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day, in honor of all fallen officers and their families and U.S. flags should be flown at half-staff.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors formally designates May  $11^{th} - 17^{th}$ , 2022, as Police Week in Hanover Township, and publicly salutes the service of law enforcement officers in our community and in communities across the nation.
