Please show a valid photo ID and documentation with your current home address to obtain a BAPL Library Card. For children younger than 15, a parent or guardian's ID and signed registration form are required.

**Access PA Patrons:** A valid home library card with an Access PA sticker is required.

### Bookmobile

The Bookmobile stops regularly at various locations in all of our service areas. Schedule is available online at [www.bapl.org](http://www.bapl.org) or at either library location.

### Account Balances & Collection Policy

Patron accounts with a balance of \$25.00 or more for longer than 70 days will be sent to our Collection Agency, Unique Management Services. A \$10.00 fee is added to the account when it is sent to collection.

## Policies & FAQs

### How many times can I renew an item?

Any checked out materials (except new magazines) may be renewed up to two times if there is no hold on the item. Renewals can be done in person, by phone (610-867-3761), or online at [www.bapl.org](http://www.bapl.org).

### Is there a fee to place a hold on an item?

You may place a hold on almost any item for free.

### Is there a fee for interlibrary loans?

There is no fee at this time.

### How do I return materials?

Items may be returned to the book drops at any BAPL library location at any time. The Bookmobile can also accept returns during scheduled stops. Materials may also be returned to the Allentown and Easton Public Libraries. The Hanover Township and Bethlehem Township Community Centers have indoor drop boxes available when those buildings are open.
