#### Items accepted:

- Clear, green and brown glass (with labels and caps)
- Food-grade cans of steel, tin, bimetallic and aluminum; empty aerosol cans; no formed aluminum containers
- #1 through #7 plastics (remove caps and crush) (NO plastic bags, film, plastic toys, or styrofoam) All items must be SMALLER THAN a 5 gallon bucket
- Newspapers (including inserts) tied in manageable bundles or in brown paper bags
- All books (hard & soft cover), magazines, catalogs, gift wrap, cards and shiny paper
- Corrugated cardboard and flatboard (tears brown or gray) PLEASE SEPARATE CORRUGATED CARDBOARD FROM FLATBOARD

- Mixed office paper, envelopes (with or without windows), index cards, manila folders, carbonless forms, shredded papers, calculator tape, copier and computer paper, etc.
- Telephone Directories
- Scrap metals (includes anything that's at least half metal) (NO propane tanks; NO sealed vessels) **NO PAINT CANS**. Motorized equipment such as lawn mowers must have gas and oil drained completely.
- Textiles (old clothes, paired shoes, curtains, purses, belts, remnants 15x15 or larger) **NO PILLOWS, RUGS, CARPETS OR CANVAS**
- White goods, i.e. large appliances, certified Freon-free

## TRASH COLLECTION

- Picked up according to you Curbside Collection Calendar.
- Toters should be placed with the wheels facing your home and the metal pickup bar facing the road. There should be 2-3 feet of space between the toters.
- Containers shall be located so as to be accessible to the collector, ground level and at a point of the curb line of the street or within 10 ft of the public street curb line from which collection is to be made.
- Containers shall be placed out for collection no earlier than 6:00PM the day prior to scheduled collection and no later than 7:00AM collection day.

## RECYCLING COLLECTION

- Picked up with your trash every other week.
- Toss **ONLY** unbagged, loose recyclable items into your toter.
- Please follow the Curbside Collection Calendar.
- If you must bag your recyclables, clear, see-through bags are required.
- **Please rinse containers to remove food residue.** All recyclables should be clean and dry.
- If in doubt – throw it out.

## RECYCLING COLLECTION

### Accepted Material:

- Cans—Aluminum beverage cans; steel and tin food and beverage cans; empty aerosol containers
- Glass—Clear, Green, and brown food and beverage bottles and jars
- Plastics #1 through #7—soda bottles, water and milk jugs, detergent bottles
- Newspaper—Including all inserts that come with the paper; bundled using twine or string; no tape, nylon, rope or cloth. Bundle should be no higher than 12 inches.
- Magazines & Catalogs—May be bundled using twine or string; no tape, nylon, rope or cloth.
- Cardboard— Clean and dry, cut into no larger than 4 ft by 1 ft pieces and bundled using twine or string; no tape, nylon, rope or cloth.
- Paper—High-grade office paper, mixed office paper, and junk mail may be bundled using twine or string; no tape, nylon, rope or cloth.



## YARD WASTE INFORMATION

## YARD WASTE INFORMATION

Material may be placed in:

- Township Yard Waste Barrels
  - open, rigid, waterproof containers
  - plastic bags **will not** be accepted
- Containers must weigh less than 70 lbs. each

### Accepted Material:

- Leaves\*
- Small Brush—up to 4 inches in diameter (no longer than 6 ft)
- Hedge & Shrub Trimmings
- Garden & Plant Residue
- Leaves will also be picked up starting the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of October through the 1<sup>st</sup> week of December when placed curbside weather permitting.

### Not Accepted:

- Grass—recycle your grass using a mulching mower or by cutting your lawn frequently and leaving the grass on the lawn. This does not contribute to thatch and provides excellent fertilizer. You can place grass out for the regular trash collection but this practice is **not recommended** by the Township or the Commonwealth of PA Department of Environmental Protection.
- Ornamental Grasses
- Dirt & Sod
- Tree Stumps
- Rocks, Mulch, Cornstalks, Rootballs
- Bamboo, Hay, Straw, Pumpkins
- Compressed wood
